

Plymouth Road Storm Drainage Improvements

Project Fact Sheet

Project Goals

1. Reduce street and yard flooding that has been reported by residents by installing new storm sewers and inlets;
2. Regrade the existing swales within right of way areas to help direct stormwater runoff to the new storm sewer system.

Project Description

City Utilities is designing a project that will install approximately 3,000 linear feet of storm sewer and a total of 33 inlets and manholes along Plymouth Road, Bruneal Street, Hampshire Drive and Wyandotte Drive to provide stormwater drainage for the area. Street-side swales will be regraded and seeded to help stormwater runoff flow to the inlets. Street and driveways that are disrupted during construction will be restored.
