AN ORDINANCE approving the Purchase and Installation of equipment and services to expand an existing computerized telephone system at a total cost of \$1,166,000 from and through G3 Technology Partners in connection with the Board of Works,

- WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne and Allen County currently share computer resources and intend to jointly purchase and share a telephone system; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne's telephone system was installed during the 1990's and replacement parts are becoming difficult to replace; and
- WHEREAS, the new planned system will be deployed across the City and County, deploying a new system now will simplify the move to 200 E Berry and avoid spending money on equipment soon to be discarded; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne and Allen County wish to gain operation efficiencies through the deployment of a new telephone system; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne has a second, existing, modern telephone system and expanding this system would save \$100,000 over the cost of a completely new telephone system; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne and Allen County each expect to reduce the annual cost of telephone service by \$200,000 upon completion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the purchase of Telephone handsets, systems, services

from G3 Technology Partners for a total of cost to the City of \$1,166,000 is hereby approved in all respects. That said purchase will be

used to expand the use of an existing telephone system for the general use of the City of Fort Wayne.

SECTION 2. That the City is authorized and directed to take all action necessary for the purchase of this system by and through G3 Technology Partners.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CONSOLIDATED COMMUNICATIONS PARTNERSHIP FUND.

- WHEREAS, an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement was entered into on February 19, 2010 by and between the Board of Commissioners of the County of Allen, Indiana and the Mayor of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana to combine all communications services currently provided by the County and the City 911 centers into a joint department of communications; and,
- WHEREAS, the Consolidated Communications Partnership of Allen County, Indiana and the City of Fort Wayne ("CCP") was created to provide for centralized communications services for certain County governmental offices, certain City governmental offices, and such other governmental and emergency communications; and,
- WHEREAS, the City Controller, as the fiscal officer of the CCP, shall have the duty and responsibility to receive, disburse and account for all monies of the CCP, in accordance with procedures adopted by the City for the receipt and payment of vouchers or claims; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The Consolidated Communications Partnership ("CCP") Fund shall be established for the purpose of accounting for and appropriating CCP funds for the operations and capital expenditures of the CCP.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
